The Alliance for Batteries Technology, Training and Skills (ALBATTS) is a European project concerning skills and competences in the emerging Batteries for Electro-mobility ecosystem.

The project goal is to support Europe in becoming a competitive player in the battery ecosystem, by providing European industry with expertise and a highly skilled workforce. The aim is to cover the whole life cycle of the battery value chain, from raw materials processing, cell components and manufacturing, to battery and battery pack manufacturing, recycling or second use, both in mobile and stationary battery applications.



Together, the consortium will define new EU sectoral strategy for the battery sector by:

- Mapping current and future battery technologies
- Identifying new required competencies
- Designing a roadmap synchronising the needed skills both from demand and supply sides

The **ALBATTS** project runs from 2019-2023 and the consortium involves 20 organisations from 11 European countries, from the industrial and educational sectors to regional authorities.
